The International Christian Church Network (TICCEN) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, young people, and adults at risk in all that we do, both in the UK and internationally.

We believe that every person is made in the image of God and deserves to be treated with dignity, respect, and care, free from harm, abuse, neglect, or exploitation.

Safeguarding is a shared responsibility across our churches, ministries, staff, clergy, volunteers, and partner organisations. We operate a zero-tolerance approach to abuse of any kind.

Our Commitment

- We work to create safe, transparent, and accountable environments
- We follow robust safeguarding policies and procedures
- We ensure appropriate training, safer recruitment, and vetting
- We take all safeguarding concerns seriously and act promptly
- We cooperate fully with statutory authorities where required

UK & International Safeguarding

- All UK-based TICCEN churches and ministries follow our UK Safeguarding Policy and statutory guidance
- International partners and churches are required to follow their own regional safeguarding policies in line with local law, and at a minimum meet TICCEN safeguarding standards
